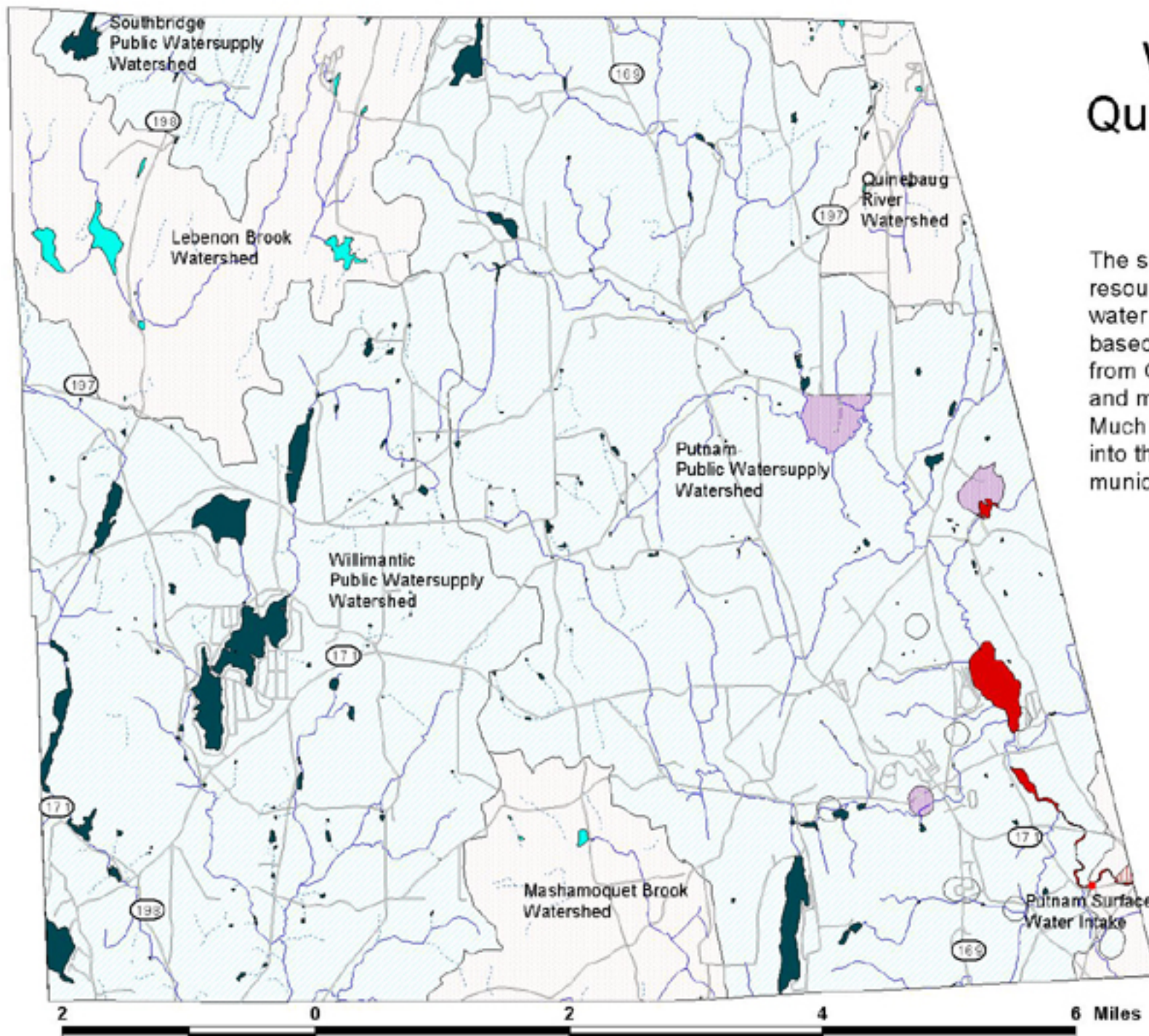


# Woodstock Water Quality Composite Map

The surface water and ground water resources of Connecticut are assigned water quality classifications which are based on water quality standards from Connecticut's Clean Water Act and mapped on a scale of 1:50,000. Much of Woodstock has land that drains into the drinking water supply of other municipalities.

  - A - potential drinking water supply
  - AA - existing drinking water supply
  - B - not meeting target class
